- c. At the conclusion of the meeting, if the meeting chair believes additional public comment is necessary, the floor will be open.

We hope that this guideline will improve the effectiveness and order of the Town's Public Meetings. It is the intent of your publicly elected officials to stay open to your feelings on a variety of issues.

There will be no alcohol consumption allowed and he would like to limit foul language so that it is family friendly. In order to shoot at night, it is required to have 2 light poles with four 1500 watt lights on each pole. These lights run about \$1,000 each so that would be \$8,000 in lights required. Rick doesn't know where the money will come from yet. Everything else has gone good. A lot of people have stepped up to the plate. Rick thanked everyone again.

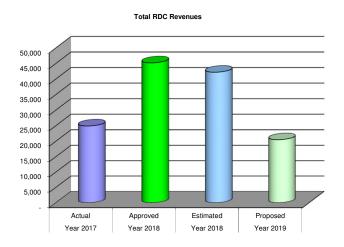

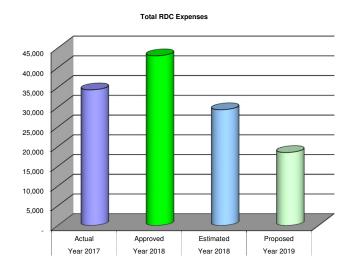
