Without people like you, we might not be able to find homes for these animals. The best part about fostering is knowing that you played a crucial role in saving this animal's life and bringing them closer to finding a permanent home. The following information below must be understood by you before you can begin as a foster caregiver.

Initial

____ I am at least 21 years of age or has a person with you who agrees to sign and initial this agreement with you.

____ I agree to care for this animal in a humane and responsible manner. In doing so you will provide food, water, shelter, and medical care.

____ I agree to abide by the Town of Rangely Title 6 Municipal Code.

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____ I agree to always keep all unaltered kittens or cats inside your home or use a Catio.

____ I also agree to always keep all unaltered puppies or dogs away from other unaltered dogs, until the puppy or dog is altered.

____ I understand that at any time I the foster caregiver can terminate this temporary foster care at any time by contacting the Rangely Animal Shelter.

____ I understand that the Rangely Animal Shelter has the right to have this animal returned to the Shelter at any time for any reason.

____ I understand that at any time the Rangely Animal Shelter can come and do a home visit to check on the animal in your care.

____ I understand that the Rangely Animal Shelter along with the Town of Rangely cannot guarantee the health or temperament of this animal. The Rangely Animal Shelter or Town of Rangely is also not responsible for any damages or injuries sustained to any person or persons property when said animal is in your care.

____ I understand that I must bring or find other options for the pet to be brought to all Rangely Animal Shelter adoption events and or for potential adopters to meet.

____ I understand that if the animal gets out of my care/yard at any time, I am required to notify the Rangely Animal Shelter immediately and figure out how the animal was able to escape.
