8) Committee & Project Updates

- Main Street: Jeannie Caldwell, Lisa Piering East end entrance is a work in progress. Soil samples are being done, also seeking fund thru Main Street. Next year will be a good year for grants and will be applying for those. Received \$150,000 grant for the Hospital for the North Park. Looking at finishing the walking/biking paths around Rangely with a possibility of an EDA grant. Jeannie showed the board the new advertising videos. Once they are complete, she will market them in specific areas. The videos will also be posted on the Town's website.
- Mountain Bike Trails: Keely Ellis, Jeannie Caldwell, Lisa Piering Scott will be coming back at the end of September. There is a planning grant for \$500,00 that would be used for river put ins, walking paths and bike paths.
- Airport: Jeff Rector, Keely Ellis, Lisa Jones There is a plan to do a reorganization by January
- **4** Cyber Security: Jeannie Caldwell, Lisa Jones, McKenzie Webber 2-year program at CNCC is running well. There are 2 certificates available to receive. With the success of the first class, CNCC is able to hire a second instructor.
- Fiber Optic-Marketing: Andy Key, Lisa Jones, Jeff Rector Included in the marketing video.
- Outdoor Rec. Tourism: McKenzie Webber, Andy Key, Ryan Huitt October 16 is Octoberfest on Stanolind Ave. Starting to plan ROAR, Polar plunge will be November 6th, planning stage of Christmasfest. On October 4th, Moonlake Electric will present at the Community Outreach Meeting at 6pm.
- Investment Opportunity: Jeannie Caldwell, Karen Reed, Lisa Piering The company Cogency is a Geo-thermal solar company looking at coming into Rangely. They have applied for federal grants. This company would provide a backup for loss of power. West End Drive In has sold, it will be a fast-food Mexican restaurant. Moosehead Lodge has also sold.
- 9) <u>Information</u> Lisa Jones stated that CNCC is asking the NJAA to add Cross Country to their list of sports. She also stated that Soccer will be moved to Rangely. McKenzie Webber shared that Student Government Day will be planned for the spring of 2022.


