 - ii. *Please keep your comments to 3-5 minutes* as others may want to participate throughout the meeting and to insure that the subject does not drift.
- b. Throughout the meeting agenda calls for public input will be made, generally pertaining to specific action items. Please follow the same format as above.
- c. At the conclusion of the meeting, if the meeting chair believes additional public comment is necessary, the floor will be open.

We hope that this guideline will improve the effectiveness and order of the Town's Public Meetings. It is the intent of your publicly elected officials to stay open to your feelings on a variety of issues.

Would like to have a goal with one win. The Board would like to see SBDC back to the community. Need to have our businesses use us as an asset. At the next meeting bring goals, possibly two big goals and 3 smaller project goals. Prioritize projects. Think about the Mountain Bike Trail System and what the next step should be. How to maximize advertising of Fiber-Optic possibilities. CNCC and the State are in negotiations to invest in outdoor rec.

Received \$50,000 to widen sidewalks in front of Town Hall and insert a new parklet, new grass and benches. Working on the East End Entrance project that will probably take about 3 years to complete. Applying for CDOT grant to resurfaces Kennedy Drive Path. Looking at doing on big event a year, possibly Food Truck Fridays.
 - ii. **Mountain Bike Trails:** Keely Ellis and Jeannie Caldwell **Working on an area, possibly North of Rangely.** Need to get volunteers to upkeep the trail system.
 - iii. Airport: Jeff Rector, Keely Ellis, Vacancy
 - iv. Call Center: Jeannie Caldwell, Lisa Piering, McKenzie Webber;
 - v. **Fiber Optic-Marketing**: Andy Key, Ron Granger, Jeff Rector; **Really need** to promote.
 - vi. Outdoor Rec. Tourism: McKenzie Webber, Andy Key, Ryan Huitt; Working on ROAR
 - vii. Investment Opportunity: Jeannie Caldwell, Karen Reed, Jason Cox Adora Inn was purchased. Subway; the franchise has been approved but Budget Hotel needs to sell for it to open. West End Drive In will be opening by April and Pippi's a sub and soup restaurant opened.
