The following is a list of PAID Volunteer/Fundraising Opportunities for the 2024 Ride the Rockies event in Rangely, with a brief description of duties.

The following is a list of Paid Volunteer/Fundraising Opportunities at the 2024 Ride the Rockies event in Rangely, with a brief description of duties. Payment is available for your time and effort.

Information Table: Event staff will train you on event specifics so you can answer questions from participants. **Pick one or more Days 1,2, or 3.**

Baggage Unloading: Riders' luggage will arrive on a semi-truck and need to be offloaded and arranged so participants can retrieve their personal gear. Volunteers should be able to lift 60 lbs. comfortably. **Day 1 only.**

Baggage Loading: Riders' luggage will need to be loaded on a semi-truck to travel to the next destination. Participants will drop their gear off in a staging area and helpers will fire line gear into the semi-truck. Volunteers should be able to lift 60 lbs comfortably. **Day 3 only**

Bike Corral Storage/Management: Cyclists will bring their bikes to a controlled access location. You will assist them with parking their bike in racks and retrieving bikes when they request. **Pick one or more Days 1,2, or 3.**

Parking Information and Control: Parking areas for different participants will be laid out on a campus map. As participants enter the CNCC grounds, you will help guide them to their established parking area. **Pick one or more Days 1,2, or 3.**

Shuttle Management and Coordination: Shuttles will be running at intervals to take people into Rangely, to restaurants, hotels, and attractions. You will help coordinate and provide information to shuttle users. **Pick one or more Day 1 or Day 2.**

Meal Prep and Serving: Dinners will be needed for Nights 1 and 2, Breakfasts needed for mornings 2 and 3, and lunches needed for days 1, 2 and 3. Your group of 10 will volunteer to do meal preparation and serving for 1 full meal of the 7 needed. Your group will propose the menu, shop for ingredients, do food preparation, operate a cash box, determine the price of the meal for each participant, serve the meal, and clean up after the meal. Up to 300-600 servings are needed for each meal. Town will establish an outdoor cooking area at CNCC w equipment for heating and serving the meals. **Pick one or more Lunch 1,2 or 3; Breakfast 1 or 2; Dinner 1 or 2.**

Snack Prep and Serving: Cyclists eat a lot of food. Your group of 6 will prep snacks for 300-600 cyclists, present them at CNCC, price them, operate a cash box, serve them, and clean up after them. Ideas: cookies in packs of 2 or 3, popcorn, granola bars, popsicles. **Pick one or more Day 1,2, or 3.**

Water and Electrolyte Prep and Serving: Your group of 5 will establish locations for 5- gallon water jugs and/or electrolyte jugs, operate a cash box, set pricing, charge for electrolyte, serve electrolyte, and keep jugs stocked. **Pick one or more Day 1,2, or 3.**

Course Marshalls: Volunteers wearing traffic vests will be trained for the route location they will be posted. Day 1 will be along Hwy 64 between Meeker and Rangely. Day 2 will be along the route to Dinosaur National Monument and back. Day 3 will be along Hwy 139 to Fruita or CR23/109/116/Baxter Pass. Transportation to and from will be provided. **Pick one or more Day 1,2, or 3.**

Floater/General Assistants: You will wear a t-shirt or vest designating you as a floater and you will facilitate activities throughout the CNCC campus and Rangely to help the event run smoothly. **Pick one or more Day 1,2, or 3.**

Coffee Preparation and Sale: Your group will establish locations for coffee preparation and sale, operate a cash box, set pricing, charge for coffee, serve coffee, and clean up after coffee. **Pick one or more Morning 1,2, or 3.**

Homestay Host: You have a spare bedroom, Accessory Dwelling Unit, Apartment, or camper/RV you want to make available June 12-14 for a fee. Campers must be moved to an established town RV park w hookups for use. You can determine price, whether you want to provide meals, policies etc. Ride the Rockies will reach out to you to discuss and connect you with interested riders. Agreeing to provide a homestay must include the following: Preparation cleaning, clean sheets and blankets, access to bathroom, electricity and running water, cleanup after guests leave.

Riding Medic: You are First Aid, WFR, EMT, PA, Nurse or Doctor certified and want to ride some or all of the course with some first aid supplies and a radio to render and coordinate medical assistance for riders. Day 1 will be along Hwy 64 between Meeker and Rangely. Day 2 will be along the route to Dinosaur National Monument and back. Day 3 will be along Hwy 139 to Fruita or CR23/109/116/Baxter Pass. Each day will require 4-8 hours. Transportation will be provided as needed. **Pick 1 or more days.**

OV Gravel Course Assistant: You have an OHV and can give riders a ride, run sweep to make sure no one is left out on the course, and perform other general tasks using the OHV to cover long distances. **Pick Day 2 and or Day 3**

Games Coordinator: You will round up yard games like cornhole, wiffle ball etc., set them up in an established area at CNCC, and charge a small entrance fee for use. You will take them down, return them to their owners, and clean up the area when done. **Days 1 and 2.**

Entertainment: You are interested in providing entertainment at CNCC. I can provide the following type of entertainment: (Examples: Magic show, Piano and singing, standup comedy etc). **Evening 1 or 2**
